- Indoor 25 yard, 6 lane pool, anti-turbulent lane markers, starting blocks. Timing and place judging equipment is a fully automatic Colorado 6, complete with touch pads at one end, Electronic horn start and LED scoreboard.
- The water depth of the competition pool measured for a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1.0 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) from the start wall is 12'5" to 10'9" and the water depth at the end or turn wall when measured for a distance of 3' 3 ½" (1 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) is 4' to 4'6". USA-S Rule 202.3.4.D.
- The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

FACILITY:

- Masks will be required for all participants.
- Team seating in separate areas for athletes only.
- Spectator seating availability: at this time there are no restrictions due to Covid. However, there is limited
 seating available in the pool area. Norfolk YMCA Aquajets asks that you remain in the pool area only to watch
 your athlete, and return to the gyms/camping areas to allow for other spectators to watch when your athlete
 is not competing. One to two gyms will be used for camping, and viewing area will be available behind the
 glass/starting blocks.
- Concessions will be offered. Personal food and drink brought by the swimmer will be allowed ONLY in
 designated areas of the YMCA. There will be no exceptions. Any coolers and drinks must be kept in this
 designated area. No glass containers.
- Disinfecting stations will be available throughout the YMCA, in gyms, locker rooms, and on pool deck.
- Norfolk YMCA Aquajets and the Norfolk Family YMCA reserve the right to remove from the premises any individual who might jeopardize safety and facility privileges.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

Pool Safety Protocols:

- 1. All Parents and family members will camp in the 2-4 gyms and masks must be worn at all times and social distancing is required. Due to local mandates and facility rules, masks must be worn while in the gyms and hallways.
- 2. No NON volunteering parents will be allowed on deck. Coaches, officials, timers and swimmers are the ONLY people allowed on the pool deck.
- 3. Markers behind the blocks, for heats will be placed on the pool deck, for social distancing, and timers' chairs, will be spaced accordingly. We could add a "clerk of course" ready area if needed
- 4. Designated disinfecting stations will be available in the YMCA lobby and on the pool deck.
- 5. We are asking that swimmers come in their suits and leave in their suits in order to limit locker room usage.
- 6. As stated above, Norfolk YMCA Aquajets is abiding by our state, local and city guidelines. We are also abiding by the Norfolk Family YMCA guidelines with limiting the number of people allowed in the pool area to 25% capacity (currently 75 people maximum including volunteers and, plus a maximum of 25 swimmers in the water), and CDC protocols.
