LOCATION:

Pool:

- 50 meter, 8 lanes. Lanes are separated by non-turbulent lane lines and have bottom stripes and turn targets. Timing and place judging equipment is a fully automatic Colorado 6, complete with touch pads at both ends, electronic horn start, and LED scoreboard. Splits and far-end splits may be available.
- The water depth of the competition pool measured for a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1.0 meter to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) from the start wall is 4'6" to 4'8" and the water depth at the end or turn wall when measured for a distance of 3' 3 ½" to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) is 13' to 11'. (USA-S Rule 202.3.4.D.)
- Relay swimmers #2 and #4 for 200 relays will start at 13' depth from the deck.
- Pool has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

FACILITY:

The competition pool is in the Aquacourt Waterpark. Meet swimmers will not have access to other water facilities, only the competition pool.

- HYAC reserves the right to remove from the premises any individual who might jeopardize safety and facility privileges.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the swimming venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) at any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- A gender-neutral/family facility is available next to the male and female bathroom/locker rooms.

MEET FORMAT: All events are timed finals. Events are pre-seeded.

Like events/distances will be swum together mixed gender, and placed separately by age group and gender.

DISABILITY
SWIMMERS:

Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Deck Referee of any disability prior to competition.

RULES:

Current USA Swimming Rules and Midwestern Rules will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

CREDENTIALS:

- Presentation of current coach credentials will be required at coach sign-in. Credentials shall be available at all times. Deck Pass is acceptable as proof of USA Swimming registration.
- In accordance with MWS Policy, only those coaches with current, valid USA Swimming credentials available will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All swimmers, coaches and clubs must be currently registered with USA Swimming.
- NO on deck registration permitted.
- LATE entries will require proof of USA Swimming registration and will be charged double entry fees.
- Athletes who appear as unregistered on the first pre-meet recon must register with Midwestern or their
 own LSC immediately. A second pre-meet recon will be run 4 days prior to the start of the meet and any
 unregistered MW athlete that appears on that list must register with Midwestern Swimming and will be
 charged an additional \$30.00 above the current MW registration fee and must provide proof of registration
 before being allowed to swim in the meet. Meet management must delete unregistered athletes from the
 meet file prior to meet commencement.
- The age of the swimmer on July 9, 2022, determines the age of the swimmer for the meet.
- Relay-only swimmers must be included on the entry roster and MW splash fee paid.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by
 a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from
 within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure
 compliance with this requirement.

ENTRY LIMITS:

- Swimmers may participate in a maximum five (5) individual events and one (1) relay per day.
- No time trials.
- The 4-hour rule will be applied. The host will accept no further entries for a session with 12 & U swimmers where the 4-hour projected time limit is reached (205.3.1F). The Meet Director reserves the right to limit events, heats, teams, and swimmers to conform to the 4-hour time limit. Teams will be notified of any and all adjustments.

- Psych sheets will be sent to the club entry chair within 24 hours of the entry deadline. Clubs will have 48 hours after psych sheets are sent to make corrections.

GENERAL MEET CONDUCT:

- This meet will be preseeded.
- Scratches are requested prior to the start of each session to the clerk of course in order to allow for and late/deck entries. **PLEASE be courteous and inform the Clerk of your scratches.**
- Fly-over start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
- Each swimmer shall report promptly to his/her assigned lane prior to the start of each race in which he/she is entered and stand behind the blocks when waiting for their heat to be called to help with social distancing behind the blocks.

- All events swum Fastest to Slowest.
- All races will finish into touch pads with touch pads in place on both ends.
- No exhibition swimming; no time trials.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

- Locker rooms will be available for restroom use only and will be monitored for usage and social distancing.
- MWS Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules.
- The "sit and slide" entry will be used.
- The first 30 minutes will be general warm-up. Lanes will be assigned to teams. Coaches may organize their own warm-up. The last 15 minutes will be used for racing starts, one direction only.

TEAM SUPERVISION:

SCORING:

- Individual points will be kept for all events (8-lane scoring 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1) for high point and runner-up; 8 & U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18. 19 and O swimmers are welcome but will not score.
- Age groups are swum together but placed separately by gender and age group, 8 & U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18.

 Special token for completion of Pentathlon events (50 Free, 50 Back, 50 Breast, 50 Fly, 200 IM) with all age groups eligible.
